

Student Homework Support and Rewards Flow Diagram

Stage 1. The setting and completion of homework; support and rewards

Support Available

1. Ask the teacher in lesson for advice/clarification about the task.
2. Speak to the teacher at the end of the lesson /break/lunch for advice or clarification if you do not wish to discuss in class.
3. Choose to attend a Subject Support Session on a Monday or Wednesday (1hr after school) where a member of staff will be on hand to provide you with advice and help with the homework.
4. Choose to use the school's Learning Resource Centre after school or at lunch for a quiet place to complete the homework and use the resources (open every day until 4.30pm).
5. Make sure when you do homework at home you are in a quiet room and away from distractions. Phone on silent and out of sight!

Homework will be set according to your Homework Timetable

This will keep you organised and ensure that you have no more than two pieces of homework a night. **Stick to the timetable and complete the work on the day set.**

You complete and hand the homework in on the deadline day and to a good standard.

Complete homework to the deadline and to a good standard

Homework Merit, 1 Merit

Homework completed to a **very good standard** and handed in, on the deadline day &/or you fulfil the homework criteria as part of the **tutor weekly Merit Award** by not getting any HOs in the week.

Teacher awards a very good work merit/Tutor Weekly Merit Award
Merit Award, 5 Merits

Teacher recommendations to the Head of Faculty/House/Year
High Merit Award, 10 Merits (Head of Faculty/House/Year, grey, postcard home)

Rewards Assemblies
Commitment to **Independent Learning**

Stage 2. You choose, despite all the support and opportunities to not get the work to the teacher by the deadline date. This indicates you must attend a subject support session.

You MUST attend the next Subject Support Session.

'HO – Subject Homework Support' recoded on your record.

Parents notified and you are to attend the next Subject Support session (1hr after school) on a Monday or Wednesday. Text sent the day before.

Stage 3. You choose not to attend (or engage with) the Subject Support session. Or you pick up more than two HOs within a week. This indicated that you need extra support and **must attend compulsory homework club.**

You MUST attend compulsory homework club

'H1 – Compulsory Homework Club' recoded on your record.

Parents contacted and you are to attend Compulsory Homework Club with Year Heads Monday to Thursday for either 2/4/6 weeks so they can support you in catching up on the work (HOs) and in establishing good learning habits using the homework timetable.
