Re: Parent Governor Vacancy

We currently have one vacancy for a Parent Governor and I would like to invite you to consider joining the Local Governing Body.

I do hope you will give this opportunity serious consideration. The position will give you an insight into the inner workings of Sir Graham Balfour School and will provide an opportunity to become involved fully, helping to shape the ethos and development of the school.

Parent Governors are appointed for a period of up to four years, irrespective of whether their children remain in school during that period. Parents of all children currently registered at the school are entitled to stand or to nominate others.

"Parents" includes step-parents, guardians, or other persons having parental responsibility. Please note if you are employed at the school for more than 500 hours in a year, you are not eligible to put yourself forward for election. You will, however, be able to vote should a ballot be necessary.

What is expected of a Governor?

- To attend meetings of the Local Governing Body (7 each academic year)
- To serve on one of the sub-committees
- To be linked to a department within school
- To attend school functions wherever possible
