In this current financial climate, we would like to remind you that you can apply for free school meal funding if you are eligible. This entitles your child to receive a school meal during the day and enables the school to provide financial support towards uniform, school resources, music lessons, trips, and a breakfast and breaktime canteen allowance.

Is my child eligible for free school meal funding?

Your child may be eligible if you access:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance or Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on
- Universal Credit, provided you have an annual net earned income not exceeding £7,400.
- Your child may also be eligible if you're in a household with no recourse to public funds (NRPF), subject to a maximum income threshold.
